Hazardous Components: Calcium sulfoaluminate (CAS 12004-14-7), Calcium aluminate (CAS 12042-68-1), di calcium aluminate silicate (CAS 12252-33-4) and calcium sulphate (CAS 14798-04-0. Minor amounts of tetra alumino ferrite, dodeca calcium hepta aluminate, calcium titanate and lime together with trace amounts of alkalis, chlorides and chromium compounds.
